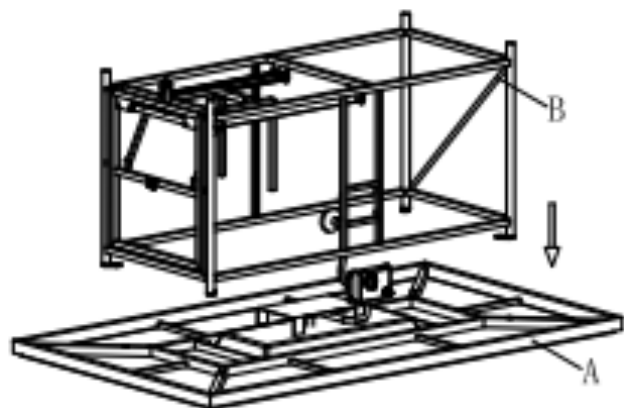
TOP TIPS

- Aluminium is a soft metal and over tightening may strip the thread or break the part, please loosely assembly your furniture before tightening to secure.
- Please **do not** use power tools, please use the Allen key provided in the bolt pack.
- Please allow 1 hour for assembly.
- This furniture can be assembled with **1** person; however, you may need someone to assist you when turning the furniture over into position.

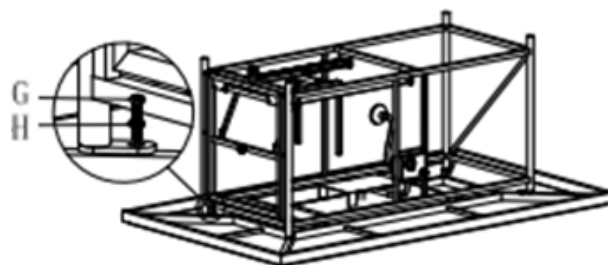

STEP 1 & 2: SECURING TABLE TOP & BASE

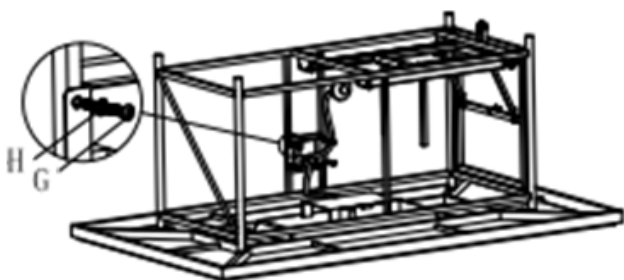


STEP 1: Turn table top (A) over and put onto a soft clean surface, be careful of the glass fixed on table top and there is no need to take out of the glass.

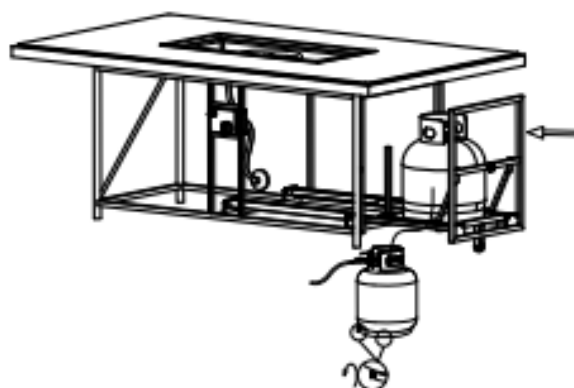


STEP 2: Attach base section (B) to table top (A) with bolts (G) and big flat washers (H) using Allen key (J).

STEP 3 & 4: SECURING IGNIGHTER SWITCH & GAS

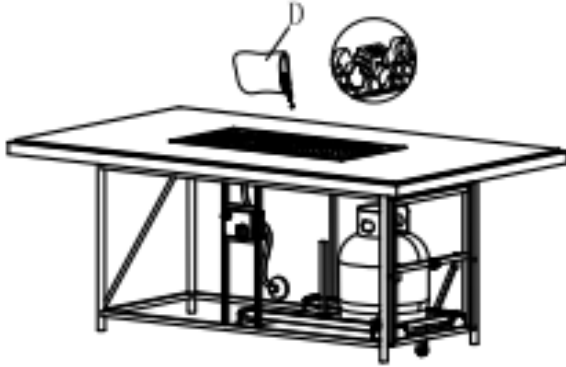


STEP 3: Attach the igniter switch with bolts (G) and big flat washers (H) using Allen key (J). Tighten all bolts one by one using Allen key (J).

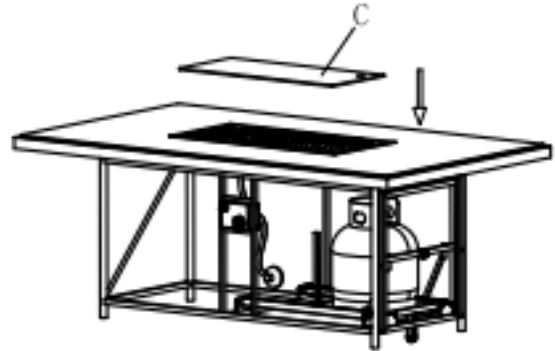


STEP 4: Turn table top over and place in desired position. Push the door on the base open along the track, connect the gas pipe then put the gas tank on the track and push to close the door.

STEP 5 & 6: GLASS BEADS & CENTRE GLASS

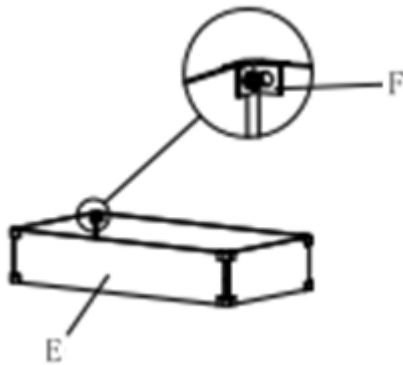


STEP 5: Pour the bag of glass beads (D) into fire pit, these do not cover the fire burner completely, as excessive heat may cause them to crack.

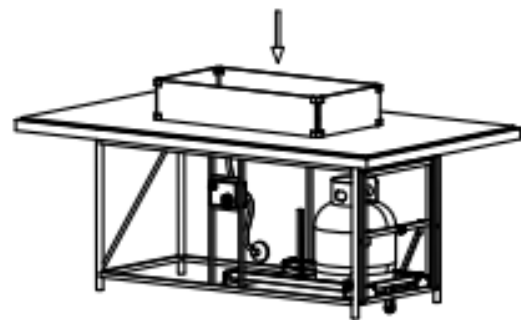


STEP 6: Put the centre glass (C) on top of the fire pit.

STEP 5 & 6: GLASS BEADS & CENTRE GLASS



STEP 7: Fire guard: fix the 4pc of glass (E) and (F) onto the glass clips (I). Note: When installing the glass clips, the direction of the clip on the same piece of glass must be in reverse.



STEP 8: Put the assembled fire guard on the correct position on table top. You can now use the table
